



The Army Leave Centre owns 35 Units at 11 locations around New Zealand.

Most of the homes can sleep six people, with the exception of Mount Maunganui, where we have a unit that can sleep eight people and at Wanaka we have one unit that can sleep 9 people. At our Taupo (Acacia Bay) location we have 2 units that can sleep 7 people. The Fire Service Members have reciprocal arrangement to use the Army Holiday Homes outside of Ballot periods.

All units are fully self-contained and have the following:

- TV and DVD player
- Microwave, oven and sandwich maker
- Electric heating and vacuum cleaner
- Washing machine, drier, iron and ironing board
- Cot and highchair is available in each unit
- Gas BBQ in the garage of each unit – users is asked to make a small cash donation to cover the refilling of gas bottles.

WHAT TO TAKE WITH YOU

- Food
- Toilet Rolls
- Clothes Pegs
- Detergent and cleaning products (oven cleaner and some old rags)
- Sheets
- Pillowslips
- Bath Towels and Tea Towels

It is your responsibilities to leave the units in a clean and tidy state. The current rate for Fire Service Members is \$55 per night per unit. Fire Service members can be booked three months ahead.
